

## WHAT IS RHINITIS?



Rhinitis, also known as coryza, is irritation and inflammation of the mucous membrane inside the nose. Common symptoms are a stuffy nose, runny nose, sneezing, and post-nasal drip. The most common kind of rhinitis is allergic rhinitis, which is usually triggered by airborne allergens such as pollen and dander.

## TYPES OF RHINITIS

Rhinitis is categorized into three types (although infectious rhinitis is typically regarded as a separate clinical entity due to its transient nature): (i) infectious rhinitis includes acute and chronic bacterial infections; (ii) nonallergic. (vasomotor) rhinitis includes idiopathic, hormonal, atrophic, occupational.

## CAUSES OF RHINITIS

This chemical can cause allergic rhinitis and its symptoms, including a runny nose, sneezing, and itchy eyes. In addition to tree pollen, other common allergens include: grass pollen. dust mites.

- Sneezing.
- A runny nose.
- A stuffy nose.
- An itchy nose.
- Coughing.
- A sore or scratchy throat.
- Itchy eyes.
- Watery eyes.
